


PRAY THE NEWS

New Caledonia has seen violent protests erupt in response to proposed voting changes. Four people have died and hundreds have been injured.



The unrest is the latest flare-up in longstanding tensions between the indigenous Kanak population and residents of European descent over the territory's political status and its relationship with France.

Human rights groups are likely monitoring the situation closely for any potential excessive use of force amid the volatile political backdrop in New Caledonia.

For the wider geopolitical implications of this conflict. That the Pacific would remain a place of peace and not an area to be fought over by world powers.
