

PRAY THE NEWS

At around 3:00 am on May 24th, a devastating landslide struck Yambali village in Enga Province, Papua New Guinea.



Triggered by heavy rains, this disaster has buried over 2,000 people under eight metres of soil and debris, marking it as one of the deadliest in the country's recent history.

The landslide destroyed homes, farmland and infrastructure, affecting over 7,840 people, including 1,650 who are now displaced. Many people are traumatised by the event and loss of loved ones.

We pray for continued peace. That the ceasefire agreements preventing conflict between communities and tribes to continue.
