Kenya is currently experiencing political unrest following a contested national budgeting process.



The government of Kenya recently proposed a public finance bill that would both raise existing taxes and introduce new taxes on goods and services. Many found these measures oppressive, resulting in strong public reactions.

On the day of debating and passing of the bill, large numbers of people took their protests to parliament. This led to an unprecedented breach of the legislative house on Tuesday 25 June.

These protests led to the deaths of 10 young people in Nairobi and 13 others across the country.

The situation in Nairobi and other parts of the country is still volatile, as political tensions continue to rise.
