



Bangladesh is currently in a state of intense political and social upheaval, marked by widespread protests.

The unrest, which began with student-led demonstrations against perceived injustices in job reservations, has rapidly escalated into a nationwide movement.

Protesters, frustrated by years of corruption, electoral fraud, and human rights abuses under the government, have taken to the streets in large numbers, calling for significant political reform.

The situation has deteriorated to the point where the military has stepped in, taking control of the government after Hasina's resignation on August 5, 2024. Over 650 people have died so far in the conflict.

The unrest has also sparked a wave of violence against religious minorities, particularly Hindus, further exacerbating tensions within the country.
