An explosive re-escalation of Syria's civil war proves that peace isn't just the absence of conflict.

Last Wednesday saw an explosive reescalation of Syria's civil war between the Syrian Government and opposition forces to Syrian President Bashir al-Assad.

Significant missile strikes by Syrian Government and Russian forces on the city of Idlib have killed eight civilians and wounded more than 50, while a swift campaign spearheaded by the Islamist militant group Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS) has retaken the city of Aleppo.

According to the Syrian Observatory for Human Rights, 618,000 lives have been lost to date in the Syrian civil war.

UN special envoy for Syria, Geir Pedersen, warns of the dangers of simply managing the conflict rather than resolving it. "No Syrian party or existing grouping of actors can resolve the Syrian conflict via military means."
