In the early hours of Palm Sunday, the Anglican-run Al Ahli Arab Hospital in Gaza City was bombed for the fifth time since the war began.

Israeli airstrikes have destroyed the newly built Genetic Laboratory at Al Ahli Hospital and severely damaged key buildings, including the Emergency Department and chapel, used as a ward for 20 patients.

A child died during the rushed evacuation after just 20 minutes' warning. The Diocese of Jerusalem, which runs the hospital, condemned the attack as "an attack on hope itself."

Al Ahli is Gaza City's last functioning hospital with surgical capacity. Despite severe shortages and repeated bombings, its staff continue treating the wounded.

With no humanitarian aid entering Gaza for weeks, the need for food, medicine, and protection is urgent.
