On Easter Monday, Pope Francis passed away in Rome at the age of 88, following a stroke and cardiac arrest.

Pope Francis brought a deep shift in tone - favouring humility, simplicity, and a Church that walks with those on the margins. He reminded the world that faith is not about power, but service.

Francis embodied the Five Marks of Mission: proclaiming the Kingdom through presence, responding to need with compassion, confronting injustice, nurturing faith, and calling us to care for creation. Whether washing feet in prisons or urging climate action, he made clear that the Church belongs alongside the poor and the excluded.

Francis never sought to elevate himself, but rather to lift up the people God loves. 'Be shepherds with the smell of the sheep," he said. His death invites us not only to mourn, but to follow his example.
