



PRAY THE NEWS

Angola is facing its worst cholera outbreak in two decades, with over 17,400 reported cases and nearly 600 deaths.

The outbreak has spread across 17 provinces, hitting Luanda, Benguela, and Bengo hardest - areas where access to clean water is limited and health systems are overstretched.

Children and young people under 20 make up a large proportion of those affected. Many families are isolated, unable to work or access food, and are now facing hunger alongside illness.

The Angolan government, with support from WHO, UNICEF, and partners, has launched a national response including treatment centres, rapid response teams, and a mass vaccination campaign reaching over one million people.

The Anglican Church is also responding - running awareness workshops, training leaders, and providing food and support.
