Access to safe and sufficient food is a basic humanitarian right.

UN agencies and NGOs in Gaza supported this access prior to October 2023, through over 400 distribution sites which delivered food, water, fuel, and baby formula.

Since May 2024, the Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF), an Israeli/US joint agency has taken over distribution. It reports delivering 70 million meals, but estimates suggest over 600 million were needed in that time—meeting only 12–13% of minimum nutritional requirements.

Today, just four GHF-run sites remain. People often walk for hours through unsafe terrain to receive dry rations, without fuel or baby food.

According to the UN, more than 1,000 people have been killed while trying to access food, including at least 875 near aid sites.
