

PRAY THE NEWS

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Sudan's civil war—between the SAF and RSF—has triggered mass displacement, famine, and the breakdown of essential services. What began in April 2023 in Khartoum has spread nationwide, with El Fasher the latest epicentre of violence.

After a brutal siege, El Fasher fell in October. Over 80,000 civilians fled in the days following, while many remain trapped without aid. The IPC has now confirmed famine in El Fasher and Kadugli, with more areas at risk.

More than 21 million face acute food insecurity. Cholera and sexual violence are surging. 14 million children are out of school. The health system is collapsing, and humanitarian access remains blocked.

With no peace in sight and global attention scarce, Sudan risks a full-scale collapse. The world must not look away.
