A generation of young people are raising their voices as protests sweep across the globe.

In Mexico, a political assassination sparked nationwide protests led largely by Gen Z activists. Young people flooded city squares demanding justice and accountability in a system plagued by corruption and violence.

This mirrors a global pattern. In Peru, youth are demanding reform; in Kenya, students are protesting police violence and inequality. In Nepal, young people lead climate strikes. In Serbia, a deadly infrastructure collapse triggered mass protests against corruption.

These movements are mostly spontaneous, spreading through TikTok, WhatsApp, and X. They're often met with curfews, internet shutdowns, and arrests.

They aren't united by ideology, but by urgency — facing climate crisis, economic exclusion, and democratic decline. For many, protest has become the only viable way to be heard in systems that rarely listen.
