## *Severe flooding across Kenya has caused widespread destruction, displacement and loss of life.*

Weeks of intense rainfall triggered flooding in counties including Nairobi, Garissa, Tana River and parts of western Kenya. Homes have been swept away, roads and bridges damaged, and farmland submerged, affecting livelihoods and food supplies. Authorities and humanitarian agencies report that many communities have been forced to evacuate as rising waters inundated low-lying settlements.

Emergency services and infrastructure have been strained, with some schools and health facilities closing temporarily. Access to clean water has also become difficult, raising concerns about possible disease outbreaks in crowded displacement sites.

Government responders, volunteers and aid agencies are providing rescue operations, food, shelter and medical support to affected communities. For many Kenyan families, recovery remains uncertain.
