Two powerful cyclones are impacting the Pacific, highlighting the vulnerability of communities to extreme weather.

In the Solomon Islands and Papua New Guinea region, Severe Tropical Cyclone Maila has reached Category 5 intensity, bringing destructive winds, heavy rain, flooding and storm surge to island communities.

Relief supplies are being delivered, with urgent needs such as clean water already emerging.

Further south, Cyclone Vaianu is tracking toward Aotearoa New Zealand, where strong winds, heavy rain and large swells are forecast for parts of the North Island. Authorities are urging preparation, especially in already saturated areas at risk of flooding and landslides.

Together, these storms reflect growing exposure to severe and unpredictable weather across the Pacific.
